Finally, an amazing Clematis collection for consistent gardening success! Pride of Place Plants Inc. is proud to represent the fine breeding work of Uno and Aili Kivistik and their Clematis cultivars.

The Kivistik family's Roogoja Farm is located in Karla village, Kose parish, Harjumaa county of Estonia. More than 100 years old, the farm is 43 hectares in size and is situated on the banks of the river Kuivajoe. Located on the 58th parallel, Roogoja Farm is the world's northernmost breeding nursery for Clematis cultivars.

The farm is managed by Aili, her son Taavi and his wife Aime since Uno's passing in 1998. Their latest generation of Clematis cultivars are new to North America and their contribution to horticulture deserves full recognition.

The **Kivistik Clematis Collection** breeding program objectives were to create cultivars with:



- **Compact growth habit**

As an added bonus, their compact habit meets today's high demand from growers and gardeners for patio and container plants and show-piece plants that are well suited to small gardens.

- **Numerous rich blossoms that develop on the current season's growth** and then last throughout the Spring and Summer months.

These clematis continue blooming (not just one or two blooms but a full load) year after year consistently, they are easy care, and survive both bitter winters and hot temperatures (Zones 3 to 9),

- **Clematis cultivars that can be pruned low** (to 6in / 15cm) so they could endure the cold temperatures of Estonia's winter, and still return to bloom year after year. And they do!

After trialling extensively in the Pride of Place Plants test gardens at Victoria BC, Canada, we are hooked - and you will be too!
